**Dear Friend of Mercy Clinic,**

Mercy Clinic has entered its fifth year of compassionate service to the community in Fort Worth without health insurance and limited access to health care.

The stories of three women come to mind. The women are in their early 40s, working to support their families, and now confronted with medical news that has captured their attention and will change the path of their lives.

**One woman** received news that she is expecting a new baby at 42. Joy and fear entered her heart at that moment, tears flowed. But in the caring environment of Mercy Clinic, she was surrounded by prayer and encouragement as we prayed for this new life.

**Another woman** came experiencing chest pain. This has caused great fear and concern for this 40-year-old woman. Although she was sent to the local emergency department, the mission of Mercy Clinic did not end. Follow up phone calls led to arranging specialist care for this woman who has a heart condition. She is surrounded by prayer as she faces this uncertainty.

**Then another woman** came with pain and a tumor has been discovered. Through a network of assistance from other local organizations, a plan is being formulated to provide medical attention for this woman. In the providence of God, she is surrounded by those who can share the hope of Jesus Christ in the midst of this frightening time.

Stories like these unfold every week at Mercy Clinic. Joy, fear, and heartbreak is met with the hope and compassion that is available through the love of Christ.

More importantly, men and women are responding to the message of hope and redemption through Jesus. Each week, patients hear and respond to the message of God's love.

Mercy Clinic is dedicated to the glory of God, and we are trusting Him to use this ministry for the Gospel.

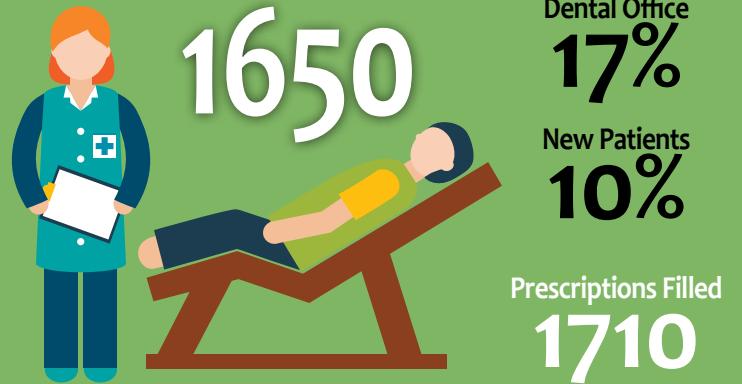
